South Carolina has experienced multiple significant weather events in recent years, including hurricanes, tropical storms, and severe thunderstorms that have damaged residential and commercial roofing systems throughout the Lowcountry. The South Carolina Emergency Management Division documented extensive

property damage from these events, creating sustained demand for qualified roofing contractors.
