Energy, homes that use 41 gallons or less of hot water daily can achieve 24% to 34% greater energy efficiency with tankless systems compared to conventional storage tank heaters.

The practical benefits extend beyond monthly utility savings. Tankless units generally occupy less space than traditional tanks, making them suitable for homes with limited square footage or specific installation requirements. Their longer operational lifespan, often exceeding 20 years with proper maintenance, also reduces the frequency of replacement compared to conventional heaters, which typically require replacement every 10 to 15 years.

"Homeowners in Vancouver and Camas are making informed decisions about their plumbing infrastructure," said Bethanie Anderson, owner of Simpson Plumbing. "They're looking at the total cost of ownership, not just the upfront investment. When they understand how a tankless system can reduce energy waste and provide consistent hot water without the limitations of a storage tank, many find it aligns with their household needs."

Beyond water heating, Simpson Plumbing in Vancouver has also noted increased interest in water filtration systems as residents become more aware of water quality concerns. Municipal water supplies meet safety standards, but many homeowners prefer additional filtration to address specific issues, such as mineral content, chlorine taste, or sediment, which can affect both drinking water quality and the longevity of plumbing fixtures and appliances.

Whole-house filtration systems provide treatment at the point of entry, ensuring that water flowing through every tap, shower, and appliance has been filtered. Both approaches address different household priorities and can be customized based on local water composition and homeowner preferences.

Water heaters account for approximately 18% of home energy use according to federal energy data, making them a significant factor in overall household expenses. Meanwhile, filtered water can reduce scale buildup in pipes and appliances, potentially extending their operational life and reducing maintenance needs.

Winter months bring particular challenges, as cold incoming water temperatures require heating systems to work harder to reach desired output temperatures.
