

## FertilityCare Canada Expands from Alberta to British Columbia with Online Restorative Fertility Services

Women and couples throughout B.C. can now access Creighton Model FertilityCare education and evidence-based restorative reproductive medicine, guided by a clinician with dual certification from the American Academy of FertilityCare Professionals (AAFCP) as both a Creighton Model FertilityCare Practitioner and a FertilityCare Pharmacist Consultant.

With this expansion, FertilityCare Canada aims to improve access to, root-cause?focused fertility care more accessible to those seeking an alternative to IVF and IUI or a deeper understanding of their reproductive health. Clients in British Columbia will receive personalized, one-on-one virtual care grounded in the Creighton Model FertilityCare System and restorative reproductive medicine.

Through this expansion, residents of British Columbia, whether in major centres or remote communities will be able to meet via secure video visits for Creighton Model charting, cycle-based health assessments, and

individualized care plans coordinated with their existing healthcare providers. By focusing on underlying issues such as irregular cycles, endometriosis, polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS), and recurrent miscarriage, FertilityCare Canada offers a restorative, patient-centred alternative for those who either cannot pursue or prefer not to pursue assisted reproductive technologies, while giving women and couples clear, science-based insight into their fertility and overall health.

At the heart of this expansion is the expertise and leadership of FertilityCare Canada?s clinical team, led by FertilityCare practitioner and pharmacist consultant Maria Bizecki. An educator and advocate in the field of restorative reproductive medicine, she has presented webinars for the International Institute of Restorative Reproductive Medicine and the American Academy of FertilityCare Professionals, and has served as a speaker for the University of Calgary Cumming School of Medicine?s Obstetrical Management Seminar and Therapeutics Course. Her clinical and teaching experience helps ensure that clients in British Columbia receive care that is both compassionate and firmly grounded in current medical science.

Restorative reproductive medicine, including the Creighton Model FertilityCare System, is a science-based approach that works by closely observing and charting a woman?s natural cycle and then using that information to diagnose and address underlying health concerns. Rather than bypassing fertility challenges through technologies such as IVF or IUI, this model focuses on restoring normal reproductive function wherever possible through targeted medical and surgical treatment. For women and couples in British Columbia, this means gaining access to a structured system of education, charting, and follow-up care that supports their desire to conceive and promotes long-term reproductive and overall health.

For individuals and couples across British Columbia, the availability of virtual FertilityCare services significantly reduces geographic barriers to specialized fertility support. From the Lower Mainland to northern B.C., clients can now access one-on-one instruction, detailed cycle review, and coordinated care without the need to travel out of province. By integrating FertilityCare charting with appropriate medical follow-up, FertilityCare Canada seeks to complement the work of family physicians and specialists in B.C., offering an
