"By year two, they were waving. By year three, they were calling out to thank us for our service. This year, it felt like we were celebrating with family. That progression means everything to us."

Looking ahead, The Dumpster Co. has committed to making the Butts County Christmas Parade a cornerstone of its annual community engagement calendar, with discussions already underway about expanding its role through formal parade sponsorship or providing logistical support for event setup and cleanup.

"Jackson gave us a chance to grow here, and four years later, we're more committed than ever," Hardin added. "We hope to be rolling down these streets every December for the next forty years, celebrating with families who've become friends and customers who've become part of our story. That's what community business is all about."

The company also sees events like the Christmas Parade as an opportunity to promote responsible waste management during a time of year when trash volumes often spike. Through social media and local engagement, The Dumpster Co. has encouraged residents to recycle holiday packaging, responsibly dispose of bulky items, and consider renting a dumpster for post-holiday cleanouts.

Looking ahead to 2026, The Dumpster Co. plans to expand its involvement in community events across all 15 service areas while continuing to provide dependable, on-time dumpster rental services with transparent pricing and dedicated customer support.
