



Knoxville Car Accident Lawyer Cite 2024 Traffic Data Showing 14 Percent Increase in Fatalities

Knoxville Car Accident Lawyer has analyzed the recently published traffic safety data from the Knoxville Police Department, which reveals that 52 people died in traffic crashes throughout Knoxville during 2024. This represents a 14 percent increase from the 45 fatalities recorded in 2023.

The Knoxville Police Department's January 2025 report indicates that 45 deadly crashes resulted in 52 deaths throughout 2024. According to the department's analysis, three primary factors contributed to these fatal incidents: excessive speed, failure to use seatbelts, and driving under the influence.

Knox County Forensic Center data provides additional regional context, showing some improvement in 2025 with 64 deaths recorded from January through August 2025, compared to 87 deaths during the same period in 2024. Despite this reduction, speed continues to be identified as a significant contributing factor in many crashes.

"These three preventable factors—speeding, not wearing seatbelts, and impaired driving—remain the leading causes of fatal crashes in our community," stated a firm representative for Knoxville car accident lawyer. "Understanding these factors is crucial both for prevention efforts and for helping victims and their families seek appropriate compensation when negligence causes devastating injuries or death."

The Knoxville Fire Department responds to approximately 26,000 calls annually, with the majority involving vehicle accidents. Department officials report that crash incidents peak on Tuesday afternoons around 5 p.m., highlighting specific high-risk periods for motorists.

Vulnerable road users faced particular dangers in 2024, with 12 motorcycle riders and 11 pedestrians killed in traffic incidents. One bicyclist also died in a crash, and the year saw five multi-fatality incidents, including two triple-fatality crashes and three double-fatality crashes.

Under Tennessee personal injury law, victims of vehicle accidents can pursue compensation for medical expenses, lost wages, and pain and suffering when another party's negligence causes a crash. In cases involving fatalities, families may file wrongful death claims, though state law imposes specific time limits for initiating legal proceedings.

The three primary contributing factors identified by law enforcement—excessive speed, seatbelt non-use, and impaired driving—significantly increase both crash likelihood and injury severity. Research consistently demonstrates that these behaviors elevate risks for all road users and often result in more severe outcomes when collisions occur.
