Factors such as tooth structure, bite alignment, and the extent of any existing dental work all influence whether veneers will produce the desired outcome.

During the appointment, patients learn about the stages involved in getting porcelain veneers. The process typically requires at least two visits: one for tooth preparation and taking impressions, and another for fitting the finished veneers. Temporary veneers may be fitted between appointments to protect the prepared teeth.
