

New Directory Ranks America's Top 20 CEO Coaches

Coaches must demonstrate a proven track record of coaching CEOs at companies with at least \$100 million in annual revenue and a minimum of 10 years dedicated to executive coaching. Professional certifications or equivalent industry recognition are required, along with published thought leadership contributing to the broader conversation on executive performance. Additional criteria include documented client results, specialized expertise in CEO-specific challenges such as board relations and

investor management, and commitment to ongoing professional development.

The directory also accepts nominations from boards, investors, and CHROs, with plans to refresh the rankings periodically to reflect emerging talent and evolving executive needs.

Research cited on the platform indicates that CEOs who engage with professional coaches often realize measurable gains in decision quality, employee engagement, and financial performance compared to peers without coaching support. Elite coaches consistently deliver an objective perspective on strategic challenges, a confidential sounding board for high-stakes decisions, direct behavioral feedback, practical strategic frameworks, accountability for leadership goals, and access to valuable executive networks.

"The best CEOs aren't looking for advice. They're looking for a thinking partner who will challenge their assumptions and sharpen their judgment," Gambino added. "That's a specific skill set, and this directory helps leaders find it faster."
