The resource emphasises the importance of working with experienced international moving companies familiar with New Zealand's specific requirements, as improper preparation can result in goods being held in quarantine or returned to the country of origin.

International Mover's analysis indicates that sea freight remains the most cost-effective method for relocating household goods to New Zealand, though transit times typically range from six to twelve weeks, depending on the departure location. Air freight options exist for urgent items but come with significantly higher costs and stricter weight limitations.

The guidance also addresses practical considerations such as electrical compatibility, as New Zealand uses 230-volt power with Type I plugs, requiring adapters or replacements for many international appliances. Additionally, the resource covers insurance options, temporary accommodation arrangements during shipping periods, and strategies for managing the transition period while awaiting household goods arrival.

"Successful relocation to New Zealand requires understanding both the regulatory landscape and the practical realities of such a significant geographic move," added Fenn. "Our goal is to provide expatriates with the knowledge they need to make informed decisions throughout their relocation journey."
