For those using fuel-burning space heaters, proper ventilation becomes essential to prevent carbon monoxide accumulation.

Regular maintenance and inspection of space heaters before each winter season can identify potential hazards before they lead to emergencies. This includes checking for damaged cords, ensuring safety features function properly, and cleaning units according to manufacturer specifications.
