The restoration company notes that many property owners discover pump failures only after flooding has already occurred.

The timing of preventive maintenance proves particularly critical as winter storms can bring sudden, heavy rainfall to the Atlanta area. "Property owners often overlook sump pump maintenance until an emergency occurs," added Magnuson. "We encourage everyone to take a proactive approach. Testing takes just minutes, but the peace of mind and potential savings are substantial."

Beyond sump pump inspection, the restoration company recommends property owners clear gutters and downspouts, inspect basement walls for cracks or moisture, and ensure proper grading directs water away from foundations. These preventive measures work together to minimize water intrusion risks during periods of heavy precipitation.

For properties that do experience water damage despite preventive efforts, rapid response remains essential to minimize damage and restoration costs. Standing water can compromise structural materials within hours, while moisture creates ideal conditions for mold growth within 24 to 48 hours of water exposure.
