Home whitening kits include custom-made trays that fit over the teeth, along with a milder whitening gel that patients use over several days or weeks. The consultation covers which method might suit the patient's preferences and how quickly they want to see results. Consultations at Crown Bank Dental Sandbach begin with an examination of the teeth and gums to check for any issues that need addressing before cosmetic treatment. Conditions such as cavities, gum disease, or worn enamel may require attention first, as teeth whitening agents can cause sensitivity or discomfort if applied to compromised teeth. The dental team reviews the patient's dental history and discusses any concerns about sensitivity or previous reactions to dental products.

Patients can ask questions about what teeth whitening is and what kinds of results they can expect during the appointment. The dental team says that whitening only works on natural tooth enamel and won't change the colour of crowns, veneers, or fillings. People who already have dental work may want to think about whether these restorations will look good with their newly whitened teeth. During the consultation, this point is brought up so that there are no surprises later. The practice has made it clear that not everyone is a good candidate for teeth whitening. Stains from some medications or damage inside the tooth often don't go away with regular whitening treatments.
