These procedures typically involve smaller incisions, faster recovery, and fewer complications compared to traditional surgeries. For more advanced or complex glaucoma cases, traditional approaches such as trabeculectomy or tube shunt placement may be necessary to maintain vision and reduce intraocular pressure.
