Glaucoma gradually damages the optic nerve and can lead to permanent vision loss if untreated. Because early symptoms are rare or absent, annual eye exams and timely diagnosis are critical. The glaucoma care team in Billings combines leading diagnostic tools with a deep understanding of the disease's progression, offering patients both preventive guidance and a full spectrum of treatment solutions tailored to their individual needs.

The glaucoma services available in Billings include a range of both medical and surgical options. Depending on the type and stage of the disease, treatments may begin with pressure-lowering eye drops or laser therapy. When surgery is indicated, the surgeons at Vance Thompson Vision are experienced in a variety of

techniques, from traditional approaches to newer, minimally invasive glaucoma surgeries (MIGS). MIGS procedures are frequently performed alongside cataract surgery, streamlining treatment for patients with coexisting conditions and reducing recovery time.

In advanced cases, procedures such as trabeculectomy and tube shunt implantation may be used to create alternative drainage channels in the eye. These techniques help reduce intraocular pressure and protect the optic nerve from further damage. Each method is selected based on a careful review of the patient's anatomy, glaucoma type, and previous response to treatment.

The glaucoma team at Vance Thompson Vision includes ophthalmologists and optometrists who are deeply involved in clinical research. Their ongoing work contributes to national and international studies focused on halting glaucoma progression and discovering more effective management tools. The team's presence in Billings ensures that patients throughout Montana and the surrounding region can access care aligned with the latest evidence and evolving best practices.

Glaucoma is often confused with cataracts due to their shared impact on vision. However, the two conditions are distinct in both cause and treatment. While glaucoma affects the optic nerve as a result of internal eye pressure, cataracts involve clouding of the lens. In many cases, cataract surgery provides an opportunity to address both conditions simultaneously, particularly through the use of MIGS techniques that leverage a single surgical incision for dual treatment.

Initial consultations in Billings involve detailed imaging, intraocular pressure measurements, and a full discussion of available treatment options. Because the disease can take many forms, patients undergo individualized evaluations to determine the most appropriate course of action. For some, this may mean years of medical management with regular monitoring, while others may proceed directly to surgery if pressure levels are elevated or optic nerve damage is evident.

Postoperative care is an essential part of the glaucoma journey. Following any procedure, patients are closely monitored for signs of healing and pressure stability. Discomfort is typically mild, though some temporary blurring or irritation is expected in the early days after surgery. Most individuals return to regular activities within a short timeframe, and the Billings team remains available throughout recovery for follow-up care and ongoing management.

Glaucoma remains a leading cause of blindness in the United States, with estimates suggesting that nearly half of those affected are unaware of their condition. The physicians at Vance Thompson Vision aim to change that by offering accessible, high-level care in underserved regions such as Billings. By combining diagnostic accuracy, surgical expertise, and active research involvement, they continue to elevate the standard of glaucoma care in the region.

Patients with a family history of glaucoma, those experiencing changes in peripheral vision, or individuals with elevated intraocular pressure during routine eye exams are encouraged to seek evaluation. While glaucoma is not curable, early intervention is key to preserving functional vision and preventing irreversible loss.
