Consultations at Boxmoor House Dental Practice include a discussion about what the denture process involves and what patients can expect during each stage. Impressions of the mouth are taken to create dentures that fit properly and look natural. The dental team may take measurements and photographs to ensure the dentures match the patient's facial structure and preferences regarding tooth shape and colour.

Patients learn about the schedule for getting their dentures fitted during the appointment. The process usually takes several visits, starting with taking impressions and moving on to trial fittings before the final dentures are made. The dental team tells you how to take care of your dentures once they're in place. This includes how to clean them every day and how to store them when you're not wearing them. Patients are told what to expect during the adjustment period because it can take time to get used to wearing dentures and talking or eating with them.

The practice has indicated that not everyone adapts to dentures at the same rate. Some patients find the transition straightforward, while others need more time to feel comfortable. The consultation covers these realistic expectations and discusses follow-up appointments for adjustments if the dentures feel uncomfortable or don't fit properly after initial placement.
