Water can travel behind walls, beneath flooring, and into hidden cavities, creating ideal conditions for mold growth if not addressed promptly. Knowing the location of the main water shutoff valve is also critical, as shutting off the water supply immediately can significantly limit damage if a pipe bursts.
