Home whitening kits include custom-made trays that fit over the teeth, along with a milder whitening gel that patients use over several days or weeks. The consultation covers which method might suit the patient's preferences and how quickly they want to see results. Consultations at Crown Bank Dental Congleton begin with an examination of the teeth and gums to check for any issues that need addressing before cosmetic treatment.

Conditions such as cavities, gum disease, or worn enamel may require attention first, as teeth whitening agents can cause sensitivity or discomfort if applied to compromised teeth. The dental team reviews the patient's dental history and discusses any concerns about sensitivity or previous reactions to dental products.

During the appointment, patients can ask questions about what teeth whitening involves and what kind of results they might expect. The dental team explains that whitening only works on natural tooth enamel and won't change the colour of crowns, veneers, or fillings. Patients with existing dental work may need to consider whether these restorations will match their newly whitened teeth. This aspect is covered during the consultation to ensure patients understand the situation before proceeding.

The practice has made it clear that not everyone is a suitable candidate for teeth whitening. Staining caused by certain medications or damage inside the tooth often doesn't respond well to standard whitening treatments. People with very thin enamel or exposed tooth roots may experience discomfort during the procedure.
