The Foleck Center joins dental practices nationwide in observing National Children's Dental Health Month this February 2026, an annual initiative by the American Dental Association that emphasizes the critical importance of establishing strong oral health habits during childhood. With recent data showing that 52 percent of children ages 6 to 8 have experienced dental caries in their primary teeth, the month-long observance highlights the urgent need for preventive dental care and early intervention.

The statistics paint a concerning picture of childhood oral health across the nation. Twenty-three percent of children ages 2 to 5 have at least one untreated cavity, while 57 percent of youth ages 12 to 19 have had cavities in their permanent teeth. Tooth decay remains four times more common than childhood asthma, causing children to miss over 34 million school hours annually due to dental problems.

"Many parents don't realize that the American Dental Association recommends bringing children for their first

dental visit by age one or when their first tooth appears," said Dr. Adam Foleck, founder of The Foleck Center. "Establishing a dental home early creates a foundation for lifelong oral health. Baby teeth serve crucial roles in speech development, nutrition, and holding space for permanent teeth, yet many families wait until problems arise before seeking dental care."

The Foleck Center Hampton Kecoughtan Family Dentistry has long prioritized community education, providing interactive presentations and demonstrations on dental hygiene and oral health in local Hampton schools. These educational initiatives reach hundreds of children each year, teaching proper brushing and flossing techniques while making dental health engaging and accessible.

Preventive care remains the most effective strategy for protecting children's oral health. Fluoride treatments and dental sealants can prevent up to 80 percent of cavities when applied appropriately. Regular dental exams and cleanings allow for early detection and treatment of potential issues before they become painful or require more extensive intervention.
