Bathroom exhaust fans that terminate in attic spaces rather than venting to the exterior represent another common contributor to winter moisture accumulation. Ice dam formation along roof edges can also force moisture beneath shingles and into attic cavities, creating secondary contamination pathways that may go undetected until significant growth has occurred.

Homeowners who observe frost accumulation on the underside of roof decking during cold weather should consider this a significant warning indicator. While frost itself does not constitute mold growth, its presence confirms that moisture levels within the attic exceed safe parameters and will likely support fungal development once temperatures moderate in spring months.
