"What makes composite bonding particularly valuable is its conservative approach. Unlike some other cosmetic treatments, we're able to achieve significant improvements without removing healthy tooth structure. The treatment is reversible, relatively quick, and can make a real difference to how someone feels about their smile. For many patients dealing with minor dental chips, gaps, or discolouration, bonding offers an effective solution that doesn't require multiple visits or lengthy preparation."

Consultations at McKennell Dental Practice begin with an assessment of the patient's dental health and a discussion about their concerns. The dental team examines the teeth and gums to ensure that any underlying issues are identified before cosmetic treatment is considered. During the appointment, patients have the opportunity to discuss what they hope to achieve and to ask questions about the process.

The consultation includes a review of the patient's dental history and any relevant health considerations that may affect treatment suitability. The practice has confirmed that the consultation process allows for a detailed explanation of how composite bonding works and what patients can expect during the procedure. Treatment planning is discussed on an individual basis, with particular attention given to the condition of the teeth and the patient's expectations.
