



USA Cabinet Store Announces Master Bathroom Remodeling Approach Aligned with National Wellness Design Trends

USA Cabinet Store, a kitchen and bath remodeling company with showrooms across seven states, announces its approach to master bathroom remodeling that incorporates wellness-centered design principles identified in the National Kitchen & Bath Association's 2026 Bath Trends Report. The company's recent Leesburg, Virginia project demonstrates how expanding bathroom footprints and incorporating spa-inspired bathroom renovation elements addresses growing consumer demand for health-focused home spaces.

The completed Leesburg residence transformation converted a cramped, compartmentalized bathroom into an open-concept wellness retreat. The renovation removed an existing podium tub and separate vanities to create one expansive space featuring a curbless walk-in shower with single glass panel, freestanding tub, dual-sink vanity with waterfall edge, large-format white and black veined porcelain wall tile, and heated terrazzo-style flooring.

According to the NKBA's publicly released 2026 Bath Trends Report, 72 percent of industry experts expect bathroom footprints to increase to accommodate wellness-centered spaces, with 89 percent prioritizing space allocation in the primary bath. "Bath design is becoming deeply personal ? designers are focusing on how spaces support a homeowner's individual rituals, preferences, and self-care routines," said Bill Darcy, Global President and CEO of NKBA | KBIS. The Leesburg project exemplifies this trend through architectural reconfiguration that creates flow between the bathroom and the rest of the home.

"The original layout presented multiple lifestyle challenges, including a podium tub that was difficult to enter and exit safely, along with disjointed vanities that disrupted the space," said Emin Halac, President of USA Cabinet Store. "Through strategic space planning and attention to both luxury and utility, we created a layout for the master bathroom remodeling that supports wellness and aging-in-place priorities while delivering the spa experience homeowners increasingly seek."

The renovation reflects several key industry trends. The transition from a small, enclosed shower to an expansive curbless configuration aligns with findings that 55 percent of designers consider larger shower size more important than having a bathtub. The barrier-free entry provides both luxury and accessibility, supporting long-term livability.

Design elements incorporate the organic and natural aesthetics preferred by 65 to 70 percent of industry professionals, according to NKBA data. The project features contrasting large-scale white tiles with black veining paired with terrazzo-style flooring that provides both visual texture and practical anti-slip properties for the wet room environment.

Technology integration enhances comfort through heated flooring installation beneath the terrazzo tiles, a feature cited by 69 percent of designers as becoming standard for bathroom comfort enhancement. This addition addresses both immediate comfort needs and long-term durability requirements.

The project's walk-in shower design features a single glass panel that balances water containment with spatial openness, reflecting a broader industry shift toward barrier-free configurations increasingly favored in aging-in-place planning.

USA Cabinet Store operates 13 showroom locations across Virginia, Maryland, North Carolina, Texas, New Jersey, Florida, and Tennessee. Founded in 2011, the company has completed more than 1,000 kitchen and bathroom remodeling projects, as documented in trust index reports.
