Dr Janine Doughty, Partner Dentist at Crown Bank Dental Congleton, spoke about the practical aspects of composite bonding. "The material we use now is far more durable and colour-stable than what was available ten years ago. Bonding works well for addressing minor cosmetic issues without removing healthy tooth structure. It's not permanent in the way veneers are, so patients need to understand that the bonding may need maintenance or replacement over time. The lifespan depends on factors like where the bonding is placed, how much force the tooth experiences, and how well the patient maintains their oral hygiene. For the right candidate, it's an effective way to make changes without committing to more invasive procedures."

Consultations at Crown Bank Dental Congleton begin with an assessment of the patient's dental health and a discussion about their concerns. The dental team examines the teeth and gums to ensure that any underlying issues are identified before cosmetic treatment is considered. During the appointment, patients have the opportunity to discuss what they hope to achieve and to ask questions about the process. The consultation includes a review of the patient's dental history and any relevant health considerations that may affect treatment suitability. The practice has confirmed that the consultation process allows for a detailed explanation of how composite bonding works and what patients can expect during the procedure. Treatment planning is discussed on an individual basis, with particular attention given to the condition of the teeth and the patient's expectations.
