The treatment planning software allows us to map out tooth movement before starting, which helps set realistic expectations. Patients can see a digital projection of where their teeth should end up. The removable aspect means oral hygiene doesn't need to change during treatment. Success depends on the patient wearing the aligners for the required hours each day and attending monitoring appointments as scheduled."

Light Lane Dental Practice has confirmed that consultations begin with a thorough assessment of the patient's teeth and jaw alignment. The dental team examines each case to determine which clear aligner system may be most appropriate. Not all alignment issues can be addressed with invisible braces, and some patients may require alternative orthodontic approaches. Consultations include a discussion about what the patient hopes to achieve through treatment, with digital scans or impressions taken to create a treatment plan showing how teeth are expected to move throughout the process.

Patients have the opportunity to ask questions about treatment duration, the number of aligners required, and any other aspects of the procedure. The consultation also covers practical considerations such as how often aligners need to be changed and what to expect during regular monitoring appointments. Treatment duration varies depending on the complexity of each case, with some patients completing treatment in several months while others may require a longer timeframe.
