Dr Mori Shahid spoke about the clinical aspects of composite bonding. "The composite materials we use have improved over the past decade in terms of strength and colour stability. Bonding is effective for addressing minor to moderate cosmetic issues, but patients need realistic expectations about longevity. The bonding material can last several years. Success depends on factors like the patient's bite, their oral hygiene routine, and where the bonding is placed. It's a conservative option that preserves tooth structure, which is why we often recommend it before considering more invasive alternatives."

When patients come in for a consultation at The Gardens Dental Centre (Smile 4 U), the first thing that happens is an evaluation of their dental health and a discussion about their worries. Before any cosmetic work is done, the dental team checks the teeth and gums to make sure that any problems that may be present are found. Patients can talk about what they want to get out of the appointment and ask questions about the process.

The consultation includes a review of the patient's dental history and any relevant health considerations that may affect treatment suitability. The practice has confirmed that the consultation process allows for a detailed explanation of how composite bonding works and what patients can expect during the procedure. Treatment planning is discussed on an individual basis, with particular attention given to the condition of the teeth and the patient's expectations. Not all patients may be suitable candidates for composite bonding, and alternative options may be discussed where appropriate.
