Winter conditions dry indoor air significantly, yet the interaction between warm indoor air and cold exterior walls creates condensation that can lead to hidden water damage.

ABC Environmental Contracting Services notes that humidity levels above 60 percent create conditions favorable for mold growth and dust mite proliferation, while levels below 30 percent can cause structural issues including warping of hardwood floors and damage to wooden fixtures. The company's experience in mold remediation has shown that many infestations could be prevented through proper humidity control and ventilation improvements.

The restoration specialist recommends that property owners monitor indoor humidity levels regularly and take proactive steps, including proper ventilation, strategic use of dehumidifiers, regular HVAC maintenance, and prompt addressing of any water intrusion issues. When humidity problems persist despite preventive measures, professional assessment becomes crucial to identify and address underlying moisture sources before they result in significant damage.
