This positions The Lab as a collaborative environment where clients and professionals can explore cohesive design schemes using real products and finishes.

To support more complex projects, the showroom is designed to include a conference room for consultations and detailed planning sessions. Homeowners and trade partners can meet with the HHI Windows and Doors team to review drawings, specifications, budgets, and schedules?helping ensure that selections made in the
