innovative wound healing protocols that enhance patient outcomes. Additionally, the surgeon has authored two chapters in a recently published Springer medical textbook, contributing to the education of future surgeons.

"These research contributions reflect our commitment to advancing the field of cosmetic surgery through evidence-based practices," stated Dr. Haiavy, who is a diplomate of the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery and former president of both the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery and the California Academy of Cosmetic Surgery. The breadth of research topics underscores a comprehensive approach to improving patient care. The artificial intelligence study explores how emerging technologies can assist patients in preoperative education regarding facelifts, while the wound healing case study provides a new pathway for further research into handling a difficult complication after thigh lifts and achieving minimal scarring long-term. These contributions benefit not only patients at the Rancho Cucamonga facility but also contribute to ongoing research and conversations around best practices for cosmetic surgeons across the country.

The timing of the opioid reduction research proves particularly relevant as healthcare providers nationwide seek alternatives to traditional pain management approaches. By demonstrating measurable reductions in narcotic requirements through preoperative interventions, the study provides actionable strategies that other surgical practices can implement immediately, as well as avenues for further research.

The research publications appear in the peer-reviewed journal *The American Journal of Cosmetic Surgery*, which undergoes rigorous scientific evaluation so that the findings meet the highest standards of medical research. Dr. Haiavy's textbooks chapters, which were titled "Breast Augmentation: Inframammary Approach" and "Capsular Contracture: Etiology and Treatment Options," appear in *Manual of Cosmetic Medicine and Surgery*.
