This development supports a range of treatments including oxygen renewal, LED renewal, microderm renewal, advanced skin rejuvenation, aerolase laser treatments, skin tightening, CLAS therapy involving color, light, aromatherapy and sound, cryobody body sculpting, halo sauna, pressotherapy IR, red light full body treatment, body massage, and weekend yoga.

The remodel addressed key challenges in establishing a commercial spa that balances clinical credibility with a serene atmosphere. The owner aimed to find a building suitable for multiple service modalities while allowing room for future growth. The design ensures operational efficiency and a polished guest experience through a layout that facilitates smooth movement for both guests and staff. The two-level structure separates functions, with the main level featuring a sophisticated entry, branded feature wall, signage, and refined front desk. Treatment rooms for facials, lashes, and specialties incorporate calming finishes, warm lighting, and integrated storage to maintain organization.

Upper-level areas house yoga sessions and a staff breakroom, kept distinct from guest zones to preserve tranquility. The overall plan optimizes workflow, with flexibility built in for expansion. Property vetting and strategic planning played roles in selecting the site, ensuring the space meets current needs while accommodating potential increases in services or volume. The project involved determining space and vision requirements, space planning schematic design, full architectural and interior design from grey box, construction documents, finishes and furnishing selections, creation of a permit drawing package, and full-service construction through completion.

This initiative reflects trends in holistic health environments where multifunctional spaces support diverse therapies. The design draws on principles that enhance guest journeys, from initial entry to treatment completion, while supporting staff operations. Elements like the branded feature wall and integrated storage contribute to a professional setting that aligns with the spa's offerings in rejuvenation and wellness.
