

SKIN Clinics Expands Access to CoolSculpting Body Contouring Across Additional Calgary Neighbourhoods

SKIN Clinics has announced the availability of CoolSculpting body contouring services in additional Calgary neighbourhoods, extending access to a non-invasive fat-reduction treatment that has gained international recognition for its technology-driven approach. The expansion makes the service accessible to residents in areas including Upper and Lower Mount Royal, Marda Loop, Bank View, Spruce Cliff, Rosscarrock, and surrounding communities served by the clinic.

SKIN Clinics, a dermatologist-led medical and aesthetic clinic based in Calgary, confirmed that the expanded availability reflects increasing interest in non-surgical body contouring solutions that prioritize precision, safety, and minimal disruption to daily routines. CoolSculpting uses controlled cooling to target and reduce localized fat deposits without surgical intervention, offering an alternative for individuals seeking body-contouring options that do not involve incisions or anesthesia.

The introduction of CoolSculpting to a broader service area follows a period of evaluation and training to ensure consistency with the clinic's clinical standards. SKIN Clinics stated that the decision aligns with its broader approach of integrating medically guided aesthetic treatments within a regulated clinical environment. The treatment is performed by trained professionals using approved equipment designed to deliver controlled cooling to specific areas of the body.

CoolSculpting works by applying precise cooling panels to targeted areas with stubborn fat. The technology is designed to cool fat cells to a temperature that leads to their gradual breakdown, while surrounding tissues remain unaffected. Over time, the body naturally processes and eliminates the treated fat cells through normal metabolic pathways. The method has been used internationally in clinical and aesthetic settings and is commonly applied to areas such as the abdomen, flanks, thighs, and upper arms.

According to SKIN Clinics, the expanded access responds to a growing demand for treatments that combine measurable outcomes with minimal recovery time. Because the procedure is non-invasive, individuals can generally resume regular activities shortly after treatment, making it suitable for those seeking body

contouring without extended downtime. The clinic emphasized that treatment planning is conducted on an individual basis following professional consultation to assess suitability and expectations.

Oghosa Ogiemwonyi, Owner of SKIN Clinics, noted that the expansion reflects the clinic's ongoing commitment to providing medically guided aesthetic services to the communities it serves. "Expanding access to CoolSculpting across more Calgary neighbourhoods allows SKIN Clinics to meet the needs of individuals seeking non-surgical body contouring within a clinical setting," Oghosa Ogiemwonyi said. "The focus remains on offering treatments that are supported by established technology and delivered with professional oversight."

SKIN Clinics operates within a model that combines medical dermatology and aesthetic services under one practice. The clinic reports that CoolSculpting was added to its service offerings following internal assessments related to safety, staff training, and alignment with clinical protocols. The expansion does not represent a change in treatment methodology but rather an increase in service availability to residents across a broader geographic area.

The clinic noted that CoolSculpting is not positioned as a weight-loss treatment but rather as a body-contouring option designed to address specific areas of fat that may be resistant to diet and exercise. This distinction is part of the information provided during consultations, where practitioners outline realistic outcomes and explain how the technology functions. SKIN Clinics indicated that transparency and patient education remain central to introducing new services.

As part of the expansion, SKIN Clinics has continued to invest in practitioner training and equipment calibration to ensure that treatments are delivered consistently. The clinic noted that protocols for assessment, application, and post-treatment monitoring are standardized across its services. This approach is intended to support predictable outcomes while maintaining patient safety and comfort.

The availability of CoolSculpting in additional neighbourhoods also reflects broader trends in aesthetic medicine, where non-invasive procedures continue to increase in popularity. Industry data has shown sustained interest in treatments that offer gradual results without surgical recovery. SKIN Clinics stated that the decision to expand service access was informed by these trends, as well as by patient feedback seeking locally available options.

SKIN Clinics has served the Calgary area since its establishment, offering services across dermatology, skincare, laser treatments, and medical aesthetics. The clinic serves a range of communities within the city and operates with a focus on regulated care, professional oversight, and treatment planning tailored to individual needs. The expansion of CoolSculpting availability is positioned as part of the clinic's ongoing service development rather than a standalone initiative.

The clinic confirmed that consultations remain an essential component of the CoolSculpting process. During these consultations, practitioners assess treatment areas, discuss procedural details, and review potential outcomes based on individual factors. This process is intended to ensure that the treatment is appropriate and aligned with each individual's goals.

With expanded access now in place, SKIN Clinics indicated that residents in newly included neighbourhoods can access CoolSculpting services at the clinic's Calgary location. The clinic stated that it will continue monitoring service uptake and patient feedback as part of its quality assurance processes.

SKIN Clinics emphasized that future service developments will continue to be guided by clinical standards, practitioner training, and patient education. The expansion of CoolSculpting availability represents one of several steps the clinic is taking to broaden access to medically guided aesthetic treatments within Calgary.
