



Teeth Whitening Northwich Private Dentist Dr Nikhil Oberai Recommends Treatments at Brunner Court Dental & Implant Practice

Dr Nikhil Oberai, Principal Dentist at the practice, pointed to the availability of cosmetic dentistry options for anyone seeking to address tooth discolouration or staining. Appointments are now bookable for those considering whether professional teeth whitening might work for them.

Teeth whitening is a cosmetic dental procedure that lightens the natural colour of teeth and reduces the visibility of stains. The treatment involves applying a whitening agent to the tooth surface, which breaks down discolouration and restores a brighter appearance. Professional teeth whitening differs from shop-bought products because the concentration of active ingredients is higher and the process takes place under dental supervision. The procedure can address various types of staining caused by factors such as diet, lifestyle habits, and natural ageing.

Discolouration often develops gradually through regular consumption of tea, coffee, red wine, and foods with strong pigments. Smoking also contributes to the yellowing or darkening of tooth enamel over time. The practice noted that teeth whitening treatments target these surface stains, though the extent of improvement varies depending on the cause and depth of discolouration. Some patients see noticeable results after a single treatment session, while others may require multiple applications to reach their desired shade.

Brunner Court Dental & Implant Practice has confirmed that teeth whitening is typically offered through two methods: in-practice treatments and home whitening kits supervised by the dental team. In-practice whitening involves applying a concentrated gel to the teeth, sometimes combined with a special light to accelerate the process. Home whitening kits include custom-made trays that fit over the teeth, along with a milder whitening gel that patients use over several days or weeks.

Dr Nikhil Oberai spoke about teeth whitening and patient expectations. "Professional teeth whitening works well on natural tooth enamel, but it's important patients understand what it can and can't do. Surface staining from food, drink, and lifestyle responds well to whitening, but deeper discolouration from certain medications or internal tooth changes won't shift in the same way. The results also depend on the starting shade of the teeth and how consistent patients are with any home treatment element. Proper assessment before whitening helps ensure realistic outcomes."

Brunner Court Dental & Implant offers consultations. Before any cosmetic work can be done, the first step is to look at the teeth and gums to see if there are any problems that need to be fixed. If patients have cavities, gum disease, or worn enamel, they may need to get them treated first. This is because teeth whitening agents can cause sensitivity to compromised teeth. The dental team reviews the patient's dental history and talks about any worries they have about sensitivity or past reactions to dental products. Patients can ask questions about teeth whitening and what kind of results they can expect during the appointment.

The dental team explains that teeth whitening only works on natural tooth enamel and won't change the colour of crowns, veneers, or fillings. Patients with existing dental work may need to consider whether these restorations will match their newly whitened teeth. This aspect gets covered during the consultation so there are no surprises later. The practice has made clear that not everyone is a suitable candidate for teeth whitening. Staining caused by certain medications or damage inside the tooth often doesn't respond well to standard whitening treatments.
