Defib Hawaii BLS Training incorporates adult, child, and infant CPR techniques, automated external defibrillator use, and choking relief procedures. The course typically requires two to three hours of instruction and provides same-day certification cards upon successful completion. Healthcare providers can choose between traditional in-person classes, group sessions for medical teams, or blended learning options that reduce classroom time through online preparation.

The training center maintains a documented pass rate that reflects its commitment to thorough preparation and supportive instruction. Students who need additional practice receive unlimited retake opportunities until they successfully demonstrate required competencies. This approach ensures that every certified provider possesses the confidence and skills necessary for emergency response.

Defib Hawaii ACLS Certification courses focus on advanced cardiovascular emergency management, including airway management, ECG interpretation, megacode scenarios, and pharmacology. These programs prepare healthcare professionals to lead resuscitation teams and manage complex cardiac emergencies in hospital and pre-hospital settings.

Beyond individual certifications, the center offers combination courses for professionals requiring multiple credentials, group training for healthcare facilities and businesses, and specialized programs for non-medical professionals, including teachers, coaches, and childcare providers. The facility also provides automated external defibrillator sales and training to organizations establishing emergency response programs.
