This recent selection coincides with ongoing changes to the traffic infrastructure in the city of Austin. Known for its outdoor culture, the region has recorded a steady number of accidents involving bicycles, motorcycles, and pedestrians. Local traffic reports and municipal safety initiatives frequently highlight the vulnerabilities of those who commute without the protective frame of a standard passenger vehicle. The influx of new residents and the ongoing construction on major traffic arteries like Interstate 35 and MoPac Expressway directly impact the daily commute for two-wheeled riders. While various general practice personal injury firms handle these cases within a broader business model, Cyclistlaw operates as a specialized firm. A significant focus of Shefman's practice involves addressing what is commonly referred to in the legal field as "biker bias" during court proceedings. This term describes a tendency among some insurance adjusters, defense counsel, and jurors to assign partial or full fault to cyclists and motorcyclists based on assumptions about riding behavior. Countering these assumptions requires specific forensic evidence gathering, expert accident reconstruction, and formal litigation. When Shefman enters a courtroom or a negotiation as an Austin bicycle accident lawyer, the firm utilizes documented evidence to address these biases and present the case to a jury when a settlement cannot be reached.

In the current legal environment, a large percentage of personal injury cases are resolved through out-of-court settlements. Many legal practices prioritize these early settlements based on their specific case volume models. Conversely, Shefman's practice prepares each case with the structural framework required for a full jury trial. Statistical records indicate a 99 percent trial success rate for the firm. This preparation model is utilized during early negotiations, providing documented trial readiness when discussing compensation and liability with insurance carriers.

The medical realities of bicycle and motorcycle accidents frequently involve long-term recovery processes. Cyclistlaw handles cases involving Traumatic Brain Injuries, spinal cord damage, compound fractures, and severe road rash scarring. These specific physical injuries require a detailed calculation of future medical costs, ongoing physical rehabilitation, lost earning capacity, and general damages.
