



Amana Care Clinic Announces Enhanced Walk-In Medical Services Across Davenport Region

DAVENPORT, Iowa - March 03, 2026 -

Amana Care Clinic has announced enhanced walk-in medical services across its Quad Cities locations to address increasing regional healthcare demands. The clinic, which operates facilities in Davenport, Bettendorf, and Muscatine, Iowa, has strengthened its capacity to provide immediate medical care without appointments for non-emergency conditions.

The announcement comes as healthcare data from the Iowa Department of Public Health shows urgent care facilities treating an increasing percentage of non-critical medical cases that previously resulted in hospital visits. Amana Care Clinic's enhanced services include expanded diagnostic capabilities, extended service hours, and additional medical staff to reduce patient wait times.

"Healthcare accessibility remains a critical challenge in the Quad Cities region, particularly when patients need immediate attention for conditions that do not require emergency room resources," said Moutaz Kotob, PhD, Medical Director at Amana Care Clinic. "Our enhanced services enable us to treat a broader range of

medical conditions while maintaining efficient patient flow."

The Davenport health clinic provides treatment for fractures, burns, cuts, infections, and childhood illnesses, along with full laboratory services and X-ray capabilities. The facility's certified medical professionals can diagnose and treat most non-emergency conditions during a single visit. Patients have the option to walk in directly or register online to reserve their place in the queue.

According to state healthcare statistics, urgent care facilities now handle approximately 13.7 percent of all acute care visits in Iowa, reducing pressure on hospital emergency departments. The average wait time at urgent care centers remains significantly lower than emergency rooms, with most patients receiving treatment within 30 to 60 minutes of arrival.

The clinic treats a range of conditions including respiratory infections, minor injuries, skin conditions, and provides preventive services such as sports physicals. The facility serves patients of all ages, from pediatric cases involving ear infections and childhood illnesses to adult conditions such as urinary tract infections and joint pain.

"Medical needs arise outside traditional office hours, and primary care physicians may have limited availability for same-day appointments," noted Dr. Kotob. "Our walk-in model addresses this gap in healthcare delivery by providing immediate access to medical professionals."

The enhancement of services aligns with national healthcare trends showing increased utilization of urgent care facilities. The Urgent Care Association reports that the number of urgent care centers nationwide has grown by 8 percent annually over the past five years, reflecting changing patient preferences for accessible, immediate medical care.

Amana Care Clinic operates as a walk-in medical facility serving the Quad Cities region with locations in Davenport, Bettendorf, and Muscatine, Iowa. The clinic specializes in treating non-emergency medical conditions, minor injuries, and common illnesses, providing diagnostic services including laboratory testing and X-rays. The facility serves area residents and businesses with medical care that bridges the gap between primary care physicians and emergency departments.
