Dr. Kinariwala completed her undergraduate education at Pennsylvania State University before earning her medical degree from Sidney Kimmel Medical College at Thomas Jefferson University. She completed her ophthalmology residency at the University at Buffalo, where she gained broad exposure to both medical and surgical ophthalmology prior to pursuing advanced subspecialty training.

She went on to complete a prestigious refractive surgery fellowship at Brinton Vision in St. Louis, training under nationally recognized leaders in laser vision correction and refractive lens-based procedures. Fellowship training of this type is designed to refine surgical judgment, enhance precision in preoperative planning, and prepare surgeons to manage a wide range of refractive conditions using evidence-based approaches. Dr. Kinariwala's fellowship experience included advanced laser systems, implantable lens technology, and complex refractive case management.

"Fellowship training matters because it shapes how surgeons think through each case, not just how they perform a procedure," Dr. Porter said. "Dr. Kinariwala's training reflects a high level of surgical rigor and attention to detail, which are essential when patients are making long-term decisions about their vision."

Dr. Kinariwala is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology and maintains active membership in the American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgery and the American Academy of Ophthalmology. In addition to her clinical practice, she has contributed to ophthalmic research through multiple publications and collaborative projects, reflecting an ongoing commitment to advancing the field through data-driven inquiry and peer-reviewed work.

Beyond her work in the clinic and operating room, Dr. Kinariwala has participated in multiple international medical mission trips focused on providing cataract surgery to underserved populations.
