The R-Series comprises the R500 at 15 feet, R220 at 12 feet, and R200 at 12 feet, balancing recreation, relaxation, and resistance training. These swim spas support low-impact workouts, including swimming, underwater walking, running, and strength

training, while also facilitating family fun and unwinding through hydrotherapy.

Insulated and temperature-controlled, these swim spas can remain operational in cold weather at a fraction of the cost required to heat traditional pools. This enables consistent exercise routines, helping individuals stay fit and potentially alleviating seasonal mood dips. Families can enjoy warm water dips or spa lounging even during snowfall, as demonstrated by users who incorporate swim spas into post-activity recovery.

For prolonged absences, a full winterization process involves lowering the water level, clearing lines to avoid freezing-induced cracks, and applying appropriate chemicals to prevent degradation. Swim spas are intended to remain filled and should not stand empty for extended periods.

These measures protect components and sustain peak performance. The guidance emphasizes that preparation is straightforward and preserves the investment, regardless of specific winter plans.
