Exterior walls also represent critical vulnerability points where water pipes running through external walls have less insulation protecting them from cold air. Insulation plays a critical role in pipe protection throughout these areas. Foam pipe sleeves, heat tape, and similar insulating materials provide a barrier against freezing temperatures. Property owners should also seal cracks and openings in walls near plumbing fixtures to prevent cold air from reaching pipes.

"Winter pipe damage is largely preventable when property owners understand the risks and take appropriate action before temperatures drop," said Michael McDonnell, Owner of RestoPros of Nashville. Pipes along exterior walls in sinks and bathroom cabinets require special attention during freezing weather. Cabinet doors should remain open to allow warm air circulation around plumbing. Near dryer vents and other openings, gaps can let cold air reach the plumbing system, making it essential to seal these areas properly before winter arrives.

During particularly severe cold snaps, allowing faucets to drip slightly can keep water moving through pipes and prevent ice formation. Garden hoses should be disconnected, drained, and stored, while outdoor faucets should be shut off from interior shut-off valves when possible.
