



Medical Interview Preparation Addresses NHS Consultant Shortage Through Specialized Training Support

The expansion comes as new data reveals a paradox in NHS medical staffing, with five NHS organizations reporting consultant vacancy rates of 30 percent or higher, while simultaneously experiencing unprecedented competition for specialty training posts. The overall competition ratio for specialty training positions has

reached 7.17 applications per post in 2025, more than triple the 2019 ratio of 1.9.

"The statistics demonstrate that securing a training post has become significantly more competitive than a decade ago, yet the consultant workforce remains stretched," said Nalin Wickramasuriya, a retired consultant paediatrician who now provides interview coaching through Medical Interview Preparation. "Doctors who successfully navigate the training pathway will find genuine demand for their skills at consultant level, but the current environment requires candidates to approach applications with exceptional preparation."

The shortage of consultants has cost the NHS at least 674 million pounds in locum consultant fees during 2024-2025, with psychiatry roles accounting for 25 percent of vacancies, followed by surgery at 11 percent, paediatrics at seven percent, and radiology at five percent. Over a third of vacancies are concentrated in Greater London and the South East.

Recent surveys indicate that 39 percent of consultants report excessive workloads all or most of the time, while 73 percent say rota gaps are affecting patient care. The Royal College of Physicians has called for urgent expansion of medical training places and sustainable workforce planning to address these challenges.

The government has pledged to expand UK medical school places by 10,000, though workforce planners caution that training infrastructure must keep pace with undergraduate expansion to prevent further bottlenecks in the system.
