Residents in Northwich and nearby areas who are experiencing extensive tooth loss may now discuss full-arch replacement options following confirmation that consultations for All-On-4 dental implants are available for private patients at Brunner Court Dental & Implant Practice. Tooth loss can affect everyday activities such as eating and speaking, and it may also influence confidence in social situations. For some people, removable dentures have long been the conventional option for replacing missing teeth. However, developments in implant dentistry have created additional possibilities for patients who want a more stable solution.

All-On-4 dental implants are designed to support a full arch of replacement teeth using a small number of strategically positioned implants. Instead of placing a dental implant for every missing tooth, four implants are placed within the jawbone to hold a carefully designed bridge of teeth in position. This approach may allow patients with significant tooth loss to regain a fixed set of teeth that remain securely supported during normal daily activities.

The treatment is typically considered for individuals who have lost most or all teeth in either the upper or lower arch, or whose remaining teeth may no longer be suitable for long-term restoration. By using dental implants placed at specific angles, dentists can often achieve strong support for the replacement teeth while making efficient use of the available bone.

Dr Nikhil Oberai, implant dentist at Brunner Court Dental & Implant Practice, said All-On-4 dental implants are often considered a more stable alternative to removable dentures when replacing a full arch of missing teeth. "For patients who have lost most or all teeth in an arch, All-On-4 dental implants can provide a fixed replacement that remains securely supported by implants in the jawbone," he said. "Unlike removable dentures, which may shift during eating or speaking, implant-supported teeth are designed to stay in place and function more like natural teeth. Following a full assessment, dentists may therefore recommend All-On-4 implants as a practical option for restoring both stability and day-to-day comfort where appropriate."

During consultation, dentists discuss how All-On-4 dental implants work and whether the patient's oral health supports the treatment. This stage often includes reviewing dental history, examining the teeth and gums, and assessing the jawbone to ensure it can support implants.

Alongside full-arch replacement options, Brunner Court Dental & Implant Practice also offers other implant treatments for patients missing one or several teeth. Dental implants may be used in different ways depending on the number of teeth that require replacement. A single dental implant can replace an individual missing tooth, while two or more implants may support a bridge where several teeth are absent in the same area. In each case, the implant acts as an artificial root that supports a carefully designed replacement tooth.

Patients attending consultations are typically given a clear explanation of the stages involved in implant treatment. These discussions may include how implants are placed, how healing takes place and how the final replacement teeth are attached. Dentists also explain the importance of maintaining good oral hygiene and regular dental check-ups after treatment.

Consultations are intended to help patients understand their options rather than encouraging a specific procedure. For some individuals, alternative approaches may be recommended depending on oral health or personal preferences. Providing clear information at the outset allows patients to make considered decisions about treatment.
