



Amana Care Clinic Announces Extended Hours for Urgent Care Services in Davenport

DAVENPORT, Iowa - March 11, 2026 - PRESSADVANTAGE -

Amana Care Clinic has announced extended operating hours at its Davenport health clinic location to accommodate increased patient demand for walk-in medical services during peak respiratory illness season. The schedule adjustment, effective immediately, adds evening and weekend availability at the facility serving the Quad Cities region.

The clinic's extended hours respond to data showing a 30 percent increase in urgent care visits during winter months when respiratory infections, minor injuries from weather-related incidents, and seasonal illnesses typically surge. The Davenport facility, along with locations in Bettendorf and Muscatine, Iowa, provides non-emergency medical care without requiring appointments.

"The decision to extend our hours reflects current healthcare utilization patterns in the Quad Cities area," said Moutaz Kotob, PhD, Medical Director at Amana Care Clinic. "With primary care appointment availability averaging two to three weeks and emergency department wait times extending several hours for non-critical

cases, we identified a clear need for expanded access to immediate medical care."

The clinic treats conditions including respiratory infections, minor fractures, lacerations, urinary tract infections, and performs diagnostic services through on-site laboratory testing and X-ray equipment. Medical staff also provide sports physicals, wound care follow-up, and suture removal for patients requiring post-hospital care.

Amana Care Clinic Quad Cities walk-in medical care addresses a documented gap in healthcare delivery as the Association of American Medical Colleges reports a projected shortage of up to 124,000 physicians by 2034. The shortage particularly affects primary care, creating longer wait times for routine appointments and driving more patients to seek alternative care settings.

Recent healthcare industry analysis indicates urgent care centers nationally handled approximately 200 million visits in 2023, representing a 7 percent increase from the previous year. This trend reflects changing patient preferences for accessible, same-day medical treatment for non-life-threatening conditions.

"Extended hours allow us to serve patients who develop symptoms outside traditional office hours or cannot leave work during standard business days," noted Dr. Kotob. "Our diagnostic capabilities enable immediate assessment and treatment planning, reducing the uncertainty patients experience when symptoms arise unexpectedly."

The clinic's services include treatment for abrasions, burns, bites, ear infections, sinus infections, muscle strains, joint pain, childhood illnesses, and various skin conditions. Laboratory services provide rapid testing for conditions such as strep throat, influenza, and urinary tract infections, with results typically available during the same visit.

The extended schedule particularly benefits families with school-age children who require sports physicals for athletic participation or develop illnesses requiring prompt medical attention. The clinic also serves workplace injuries requiring immediate evaluation and documentation.

Industry data shows patients choosing urgent care over hospital emergency departments for non-critical conditions save an average of two to three hours in wait time. Additionally, urgent care visits typically cost 80 percent less than emergency department visits for comparable conditions.

Amana Care Clinic operates walk-in medical facilities in Davenport, Bettendorf, and Muscatine, Iowa, serving the Quad Cities region. The clinic provides urgent care services for non-emergency medical conditions with

on-site laboratory and X-ray capabilities. Certified healthcare professionals staff the facilities, treating acute illnesses and minor injuries without appointment requirements.
