Emergency dental care focuses on identifying the cause of sudden symptoms and taking appropriate steps to relieve pain or stabilise the affected area. In many cases, the first priority is to control discomfort and address the immediate issue, whether that involves repairing a damaged tooth, treating an infection, or assessing injuries following an accident.

Dr Chetan Mathias, general dentist at Light Lane Dental Practice, explained that rapid assessment can make a considerable difference when patients experience urgent dental problems. "Dental emergencies often involve pain or swelling that can escalate quickly," he said. "A prompt examination allows the dentist to identify the source of the problem and take steps to relieve symptoms while planning any further treatment that may be required."

During an urgent appointment, dentists typically examine the affected tooth or area of the mouth and ask questions about how the problem began. This helps determine whether the issue relates to decay, trauma, infection, or another underlying condition. Where appropriate, the dentist may also discuss temporary measures to protect the tooth until further treatment can be arranged.

Patients who attend emergency consultations are also given guidance on how to care for the affected area afterwards. Advice may include maintaining oral hygiene carefully, avoiding certain foods, or returning for a follow-up appointment if additional treatment is necessary.

Treatments such as fillings may be recommended when tooth decay is detected, while gum care can help manage early signs of gum disease. Preventive advice also forms an important part of general dentistry, with dentists offering guidance on brushing techniques, dietary habits and other steps that support good oral health.

For many patients, the aim of regular dental visits is to avoid emergencies altogether. By identifying problems early, dentists are often able to intervene before discomfort or infection develops. Nevertheless, the practice

recognises that urgent situations can still occur and therefore continues to accommodate patients who require prompt attention.
