Loss of multiple teeth can affect daily routines in ways that extend beyond appearance. Chewing certain foods may become difficult, speech can change, and many people report a gradual decline in confidence when smiling or speaking in social situations. While removable dentures have traditionally been used to replace missing teeth, developments in implant dentistry have introduced additional approaches designed to offer greater stability.

All-On-4 dental implants are designed to replace a full arch of teeth using four carefully positioned implants within the jaw. These implants act as artificial roots that support a fixed bridge of replacement teeth. By anchoring the bridge to the implants, the restoration remains securely supported and does not rely on adhesives or daily removal in the way that conventional dentures do.

This method is often considered for patients who have lost most or all of their teeth in either the upper or lower arch, or where the remaining teeth may not be suitable for long-term restoration. The implants are placed in specific positions so that they can provide support for the replacement teeth while making efficient use of the available bone structure.

Dr Natasja Kashyap, private dentist at The Croft Dental & Implant Practice, said that All-On-4 dental implants can provide a practical solution for certain patients facing extensive tooth loss. "When someone has lost most of their teeth, restoring comfort and function becomes a priority," she explained. "All-On-4 implants allow a full arch of teeth to be supported on a small number of implants, which can provide a stable alternative to removable dentures for many suitable cases."

The initial consultation stage is intended to determine whether this form of treatment is appropriate for the patient's oral health. Dentists typically examine the teeth and gums, discuss the patient's dental history and consider factors such as bone health before outlining possible treatment options.

In addition to full-arch restoration using All-On-4 dental implants, The Croft Dental & Implant Practice also offers other implant treatments for patients who may be missing one or several teeth. Dental implants can be used in different ways depending on the number of teeth requiring replacement. A single dental implant may be placed to support one missing tooth, while two or more implants can anchor a bridge when several neighbouring teeth are absent. In each situation, the implant functions as a stable base within the jaw, supporting a carefully designed replacement tooth.

Patients considering implant treatment often begin with questions about how the process works. Consultations usually involve explaining the stages involved in placing implants, the time required for healing and the steps taken before the final restoration is fitted. Dentists also discuss how patients can maintain good oral hygiene around implants to support long-term results.

The consultation stage allows individuals to review these options and ask questions about the procedures

involved. Not every patient will require full-arch replacement, and in some situations, simpler implant treatments may provide the most appropriate solution.
