



## **Dental Implants Hemel Hempstead Private Dentist Dr Dhivesh Patel Recommends Consultations for Missing Teeth at Boxmoor House Dental Practice**

With the availability of dental implant treatment consultations at Boxmoor House Dental Practice, patients and families in Hemel Hempstead dealing with missing teeth may now explore restorative treatment options. The announcement from the local practice highlights the availability of appointments for individuals seeking long-term solutions to replace single or multiple missing teeth.

Tooth loss can affect daily life in a number of ways. Beyond changes in appearance, missing teeth may alter the way people chew or speak, and over time the surrounding teeth may shift slightly if a gap remains untreated. Dentists often encourage patients to seek advice about replacement options so that the condition of the mouth can be assessed and appropriate treatment discussed.

Dental implants are small titanium posts placed in the jaw to act as artificial tooth roots. Once positioned, the implant gradually integrates with the surrounding bone, creating a stable foundation for a replacement tooth or bridge. The visible part of the restoration is designed to resemble a natural tooth in both shape and colour, allowing it to blend with the rest of the smile.

For many patients, implants are considered because they provide support that does not rely on neighbouring teeth. Traditional bridges may require surrounding teeth to be prepared to hold the replacement in place, whereas implants function independently within the jaw. This approach can help maintain the natural structure of the remaining teeth while restoring the gap left by tooth loss.

Dr Dhivesh Patel, private dentist at Boxmoor House Dental Practice, said that implant treatment has become an established option for patients seeking a stable replacement for missing teeth. "Dental implants can provide a reliable way of restoring a tooth that has been lost due to decay, injury or other dental conditions," he explained. "A consultation allows the dentist to assess the health of the gums and bone and determine whether implant treatment is likely to be suitable for the individual patient."

Initial consultations usually involve a detailed examination of the mouth along with a discussion about the patient's dental history and expectations. Dentists often explain the stages involved in implant treatment, the healing time required after placement and the care needed to maintain good oral hygiene around the implant.

Single dental implants are commonly used when only one tooth is missing. In this situation, a single implant is placed in the jaw and topped with a custom-made crown designed to match the surrounding teeth. The result is intended to restore the appearance and function of the lost tooth without affecting neighbouring teeth.

Dentists may recommend this approach when the adjacent teeth are healthy and do not require restorative work themselves. By supporting the replacement tooth independently, the implant allows the surrounding teeth to remain largely unchanged while the gap is restored.

Consultations for single tooth implants generally focus on assessing bone health, examining the condition of the gums and discussing the expected timeline of treatment. Patients are also given guidance on how implants should be cared for once the restoration has been completed.

All-On-4 dental implants are used when a patient has lost most or all teeth in one arch of the mouth. In this method, a small number of implants are placed strategically within the jaw to support a full arch of replacement teeth. The implants provide the stability needed to hold the bridge securely in position.

This approach may be discussed with patients who have experienced extensive tooth loss or whose remaining teeth cannot be restored. Dentists explain how the implants support the bridge and outline the stages involved in planning, placement and fitting the final teeth.
