## Kick It 3v3 Soccer Announces 2026 World Tour with Events in Cities Hosting World Cup Matches

Kick It 3v3 Soccer, a 3v3 soccer tournament series in the United States, announced today the launch of the Kick It 3v3 World Tour for 2026, expanding its tournament schedule across the country and welcoming teams from around the world to participate.

As global attention turns to North America for the FIFA World Cup in 2026, Kick It 3v3 Soccer will host tournaments in cities across the United States where World Cup matches will be played, giving players and families the opportunity to compete in their own soccer events while traveling to attend matches.

Many of these tournaments will be scheduled the day before or the day after World Cup matches, creating an opportunity for players, families, and fans to combine travel to the tournament with participation in a competitive soccer event of their own.

"2026 will be one of the most exciting years for soccer in the United States," said Dan Stratford, owner of

Kick It 3v3 Soccer. ?We recently expanded our event nationwide to even more cities across the US in 2026 and are welcoming more international players than ever to compete in the Kick It 3v3 World Tour while fans travel to experience international soccer matches.?

The organization reports that it plans to increase the number of tournaments held across the United States in 2026. The company states that more than 20 events are listed on the Kick It website and over 20 additional events are expected to be announced in the coming weeks.

Players traveling to cities hosting World Cup matches in 2026 will have the opportunity to register for Kick It tournaments scheduled around those match dates, allowing teams and individuals to participate while visiting those cities.

In addition to its traditional 3v3 tournaments for youth and adults, Kick It 3v3 Soccer is introducing several new competition formats in 2026. The organization will offer individual competitions called 1v1 Soccer Championships, which are described as fast-paced competitions played on specially designed inflatable soccer fields.

The company will also introduce 2v2 Soccer Tennis, described as a non-contact competition focused on ball control and skill that allows families, parents, and coaches to compete together. Players will also have the option to register individually, making it possible for athletes to participate even if they do not have a full team.

According to the organization, the 2026 season will conclude with the Kick It 3v3 World Finals and World Championship in Vail, Colorado, held at the end of July. The Vail event has been part of the Kick It tournament series for more than 25 years, attracting teams from across the United States and internationally.

The organization reports that all registered teams will receive commemorative 2026 Kick It 3v3 World Tour T-shirts as part of their registration. For younger players, Kick It will offer inflatable boundary fields for younger age groups, which the organization states creates faster and more engaging games. Older divisions will primarily play on traditional lined 3v3 fields.

"The different field formats allow us to provide age-appropriate experiences for all participants while maintaining the competitive integrity that coaches value for player development," said a company representative.

Kick It 3v3 Soccer encourages teams and players to visit [KickItSoccer.com](https://kickitsoccer.com) regularly as new tournament locations are added. The organization states that if players do not see an event scheduled near their location, they are encouraged to contact the organization to explore opportunities for scheduling a tournament in their area.

The company notes that tournament formats vary by location and age group, with some events featuring traditional outdoor fields while others utilize indoor facilities or specialized surfaces depending on the venue and local requirements.

Registration information and tournament schedules are available through the organization's website, where participants can find details about specific events, age divisions, and competition formats available in each city.

The organization emphasizes that the tournament series aims to provide competitive opportunities for players of various skill levels, from recreational participants to more experienced athletes seeking high-level competition.
