



Porcelain Veneers Pimlico Victoria London Cosmetic Dentist Dr Mori Shahid Suggests Treatment Consultations at McKennell Dental Practice

Porcelain veneers are thin, custom-made coverings that are placed over the front surface of the teeth. They are designed to improve the appearance of teeth by adjusting aspects such as shape, colour, and alignment. The process typically involves preparing the surface of the tooth before bonding the veneer into place, creating a natural-looking finish that blends with surrounding teeth.

According to information shared by McKennell Dental Practice, veneers are often considered where there are

visible cosmetic concerns that cannot be addressed through routine teeth whitening or minor adjustments alone. They may be used to improve the appearance of chipped teeth, worn edges, or uneven spacing. The dental team noted that treatment planning takes into account the condition of the teeth and gums, as well as the overall balance of the smile.

Consultations for porcelain veneers at McKennell Dental Practice generally begin with a discussion about the patient's dental history and any concerns relating to the appearance of their teeth. The dental team may examine the teeth and gums to assess their condition and determine whether veneers are a suitable option. Imaging or photographs may be used to provide a clearer understanding of the current appearance and to support treatment planning.

During the consultation, patients are given time to ask questions about how veneers are applied, how they are maintained, and what changes may be expected following treatment. Dr Mori Shahid noted that suitability is always assessed on an individual basis, and not all patients may be appropriate candidates for veneers. In some cases, alternative cosmetic treatments may be recommended depending on the findings of the assessment.

Evidence from long-term clinical research has also been referenced in relation to veneer treatment. A 2012 retrospective study titled 'Clinical performance of porcelain laminate veneers for up to 20 years', published in the International Journal of Prosthodontics and conducted in Austria by Beier US, Kapferer I, Burtscher D, and Dumfahrt H, reported that porcelain veneers demonstrate strong durability over extended periods. The study found an estimated survival rate of 93.5% over 10 years, supporting their use as a long-term restorative option. At the same time, the researchers noted that higher risks of failure were observed in certain cases, including patients with bruxism or non-vital teeth, highlighting the importance of individual assessment before treatment.

Alongside porcelain veneers, McKennell Dental Practice provides a range of cosmetic dental treatments that may be considered to improve the appearance of teeth. These include teeth whitening, composite bonding, and other approaches that address specific cosmetic concerns. Each option is discussed in relation to the patient's dental condition and the outcome being considered.

Teeth whitening is commonly used to address staining or discolouration, while composite bonding may be

considered for small chips or gaps. These treatments differ in how they are carried out and in the type of results they may provide. The dental team explains these differences during consultations so that patients can understand how each option works and how it may relate to their individual situation.

The way McKennell Dental Practice does consultations is set up so that patients get clear and fair information before they make any choices. The conversation might cover the different stages of treatment, how long it will take, and how important it is to care for one's oral health after cosmetic treatment. This method gives patients time to think about their choices and voice any worries during the appointment.

The practice noted that cosmetic dentistry continues to attract interest from individuals seeking to address visible concerns while maintaining a natural appearance.
