Graff Nissan of Okemos features the 2026 Nissan Pathfinder among its current new vehicle offerings. The dealership maintains detailed specifications for the model on its dedicated Pathfinder information page, outlining the SUV's design, performance, and equipment as part of its standard inventory presentation.

The 2026 Nissan Pathfinder is configured as a three-row midsize SUV capable of seating up to eight passengers in standard layout or seven with available second-row captain's chairs. Rear seats fold to provide up to 80.5 cubic feet of cargo volume. The powertrain consists of a 3.5-liter V6 engine that generates 284 horsepower and 259 pound-feet of torque on most trims, while the Rock Creek variant increases output to 295 horsepower and 270 pound-feet. This engine pairs with a nine-speed automatic transmission equipped with manual shift mode and steering wheel-mounted paddle shifters. When properly equipped, the vehicle supports a maximum towing capacity of 6,000 pounds.

Drive and terrain modes total seven, encompassing Mud/Rut, Sand, Snow, Tow with integrated Downhill

Speed Control, Sport, and Eco settings. These modes adjust throttle response, transmission shift points, and other parameters to match specific driving environments. Standard safety systems fall under Nissan Safety Shield 360, incorporating automatic emergency braking with pedestrian detection, blind spot warning, rear cross traffic alert, lane departure warning with lane departure prevention, and high beam assist. ProPILOT Assist remains available as an option, delivering adaptive cruise control with stop-and-go functionality and steering assistance for maintained lane position on compatible highways.

Interior technology centers on a 12.3-inch touchscreen display that supports wireless Apple CarPlay and Android Auto connectivity. The NissanConnect platform facilitates remote access features through a mobile application, including engine start, vehicle locator, and status monitoring. An in-vehicle Wi-Fi hotspot accommodates up to seven devices on select configurations. Available audio upgrades include a Bose Premium Audio System with 13 speakers. Other optional elements consist of a panoramic moonroof, wireless device charging pad with magnetic alignment, head-up display, and an HD Enhanced Intelligent Around View Monitor that provides multiple camera perspectives for low-speed maneuvering.

Trim structure includes the SV model equipped with roof rails, heated front seats, and LED headlights; the SL trim adding TailorFit leather-appointed seats, a 12.3-inch digital instrument cluster, and additional comfort features; the Platinum trim incorporating 20-inch machined alloy wheels, ventilated front seats, climate-controlled rear seats, and premium leather upholstery; and the Rock Creek trim featuring off-road tuned suspension, all-terrain tires, black tubular roof rack, and distinctive exterior accents. Both front-wheel drive and intelligent all-wheel drive configurations remain available across the lineup.

Matt Sloan, general manager at Graff Nissan of Okemos, said, "The 2026 Pathfinder integrates established V6 performance with updated display and connectivity elements that correspond to current expectations in the three-row SUV category."

Andy Ooten, sales manager, said, "This model's combination of seating capacity, towing capability, and standard safety technologies positions it within ongoing developments in family-oriented midsize SUVs."

The dealership's Pathfinder details also reference SiriusXM with 360L satellite radio and connected garage integration through myQ on higher trims. These specifications align with manufacturer guidelines for the current model year.

Graff Nissan of Okemos carries a range of new Nissan vehicles, encompassing SUVs, trucks, sedans, coupes, and electric models. Pre-owned inventory includes various makes and models.
