Underlayment, which serves as a critical moisture barrier beneath the roofing surface, can degrade over time due to continuous heat exposure. Once compromised, this layer can allow water intrusion even when the outer roofing materials appear intact.

The company also noted that flat roofing systems frequently experience drainage-related issues, including ponding water and coating wear. These conditions can contribute to premature material breakdown if not addressed through regular maintenance or timely repairs. In some cases, small drainage issues can develop into more significant concerns if debris accumulation or improper slope prevents water from properly exiting the roof surface.

Additional insight into these types of roofing concerns has been outlined in a recent industry article discussing common roofing problems in Tucson homes.

The identification of these common issues follows the company's recent operational expansion, which included relocating to a larger Tucson facility to support continued service demand across the region. In addition to structural concerns, Contreras emphasized the importance of early detection and routine inspections. Small issues such as minor cracks, loose tiles, or compromised flashing can often be addressed before they develop into more extensive and costly repairs. Proactive maintenance allows homeowners to address localized problems without requiring larger-scale interventions.

The company also noted that many homeowners are unaware of the condition of their roof until a problem becomes urgent. Because roofing systems are not regularly visible, potential issues can go unnoticed until signs such as interior water damage or visible exterior wear begin to appear.
