Learning Tree Academy Announces Ongoing Enrollment for Daycare Programs in Wood-Ridge

Learning Tree Academy maintains year-round enrollment for its daycare programs at the Wood-Ridge location. The academy continues to accept applications for infant, toddler, preschool, and pre-kindergarten care to support families in the area seeking consistent early childhood education options.

The daycare center serves children starting from six weeks old through preschool age. Infant care accommodates children from six weeks to 18 months with focused attention on individual needs during this foundational stage. Daily routines include feeding, diapering, and gentle stimulation through sensory activities and caregiver interaction.

Toddler programs cover children from 18 months to three years. Activities incorporate sensory-rich play, group interactions, movement, music, stories, and songs to encourage exploration and development.

Preschool programs address children ages three to five, building on foundational skills in preparation for kindergarten. The curriculum emphasizes social, emotional, physical, and academic growth through structured yet play-based learning. A universal pre-kindergarten classroom operates in partnership with the

Carlstadt School District for eligible children, aligning with public school standards to facilitate smooth transitions.

The Creative Curriculum® serves as the primary framework across programs. This research-based approach views every part of the day as a learning opportunity. It supports comprehensive child development by integrating play with intentional teaching practices. Social-emotional skills develop through interactions that teach sharing, cooperation, and emotional expression. Physical development occurs via movement activities and gross motor play. Cognitive growth happens through exploration of shapes, colors, numbers, and problem-solving tasks. Language skills advance with daily reading, conversations, and vocabulary-building exercises.

Safety remains a core element of operations. The facility features 24/7 video surveillance, a secure entry system, and commercial-grade UV air purification to maintain a healthy environment. Class sizes stay limited to allow individualized attention from experienced teachers. The Positive Discipline method guides behavior support, emphasizing respect, problem-solving, and personal responsibility.

Nataliya Malinovsky, the owner of Learning Tree Academy, said, "Our programs provide a consistent structure that helps children build skills steadily from infancy through preschool."

Summer camp extends learning into the warmer months for preschool through first-grade children. Weekly themes combine art, science, math, and exploration with daily crafts and occasional special workshops. Enrollment for summer camp opens in February, with spots filling based on availability.

The academy serves families from Wood-Ridge and surrounding communities in Bergen, Hudson, and Passaic Counties, including Bogota, Carlstadt, Hackensack, Little Ferry, Lyndhurst, Ridgefield Park, Rutherford, Secaucus, and Wallington. A 10 percent sibling discount applies to families with multiple children enrolled. Families provide meals and snacks in accordance with nutrition guidelines and allergy policies. Enrollment proceeds on a rolling basis for daycare programs, with preschool tied more closely to the academic calendar.

Malinovsky continued, "The partnership with local school districts allows us to support children's educational continuity from early care into formal schooling."

Teachers and staff bring extensive experience in early childhood education. Ongoing professional development keeps practices aligned with current educational standards. The nurturing environment functions as a home away from home, where children explore safely, develop confidence, and cultivate a positive attitude toward learning and discovery.

Learning Tree Academy operates as an early childhood care and education provider in Wood-Ridge, NJ. The academy delivers infant care through preschool programs, universal pre-kindergarten in collaboration with the Carlstadt School District, before and after-school care, and summer camp options.
