



Vietnam Emerges as a Premier Destination for Australian Dental Tourists: A 2026 Industry Report by VNDentalTravel

An All-on-4 full-mouth implant procedure that costs upwards of AUD 32,000 in Australia can be completed in Vietnam for AUD 6,200 to AUD 11,600, even when accounting for return flights and accommodation. It is this compelling arithmetic that has made dental tourism in Vietnam one of the fastest-growing segments of international medical travel originating from the Asia-Pacific region.

A common concern among patients considering overseas dental care is whether the quality of treatment will match what they would receive at home. The evidence increasingly suggests that, for patients who choose reputable clinics, the answer is yes. Vietnamese dental clinics servicing international patients have invested heavily in modern diagnostic and treatment technology, including 3D cone beam computed tomography (CBCT) scanning, CAD/CAM digital prosthetics, and guided implant surgery systems.

Critically, the implant systems used in Vietnam's leading clinics are the same internationally recognised brands trusted by dentists in Australia and New Zealand. Brands such as Straumann (Switzerland), Nobel Biocare (Switzerland), Neodent (Switzerland), Osstem (South Korea), and Hiosen (USA) are all available, each backed by extensive clinical research and long-term warranty programmes. Straumann implants, for instance, carry a lifetime warranty when placed at VNDentalTravel's partner clinics, providing patients with the same long-term assurance they would expect from a premium provider in Sydney or Melbourne.

The dental specialists working with VNDentalTravel hold qualifications from accredited Vietnamese universities and, in many cases, have completed postgraduate training or professional development programmes overseas.
