



Vilchis Tree Services Pro Releases 2026 Tree Removal Cost Guide for Metro Atlanta Homeowners

Acworth GA March 2026 Vilchis Tree Services Pro has released a new pricing guide that explains current tree removal costs across Metro Atlanta. The company notes that species also affects pricing. Pine trees are common in Acworth and nearby areas. Pine removal often ranges from 400 dollars to 1500 dollars because of their straight structure which can support efficient crane work. Oak trees require more time and control due to their weight and wide canopy. Oak removal can range from 800 dollars to more than 3000 dollars depending on size and access.

The guide also addresses dead and damaged trees. These trees may cost less in some cases because crews can remove sections faster. However weak structure increases risk. Crews must use more safety measures which can balance out any time savings. The company advises property owners to remove hazardous trees early to reduce both risk and long term cost.

Stump grinding often costs between 100 dollars and 400 dollars per stump based on diameter. Emergency tree removal is another key topic in the guide. Storm damage in Georgia often leads to urgent service needs. The company states that properties with open space often allow faster work while tight spaces increase labor time.

neighborhoods. He added that many people only see wide price ranges online and need data that reflects actual jobs in Acworth and nearby cities.

Laldin said that transparency helps homeowners plan and avoid delays. He said clear expectations allow property owners to make decisions about removal trimming or maintenance before a problem grows. He also said that early action can prevent higher costs tied to storm damage or structural risk.

The guide also explains permit considerations in Georgia. Some cities and counties require permits for removing large trees or protected species. Cobb County and several Metro Atlanta municipalities have rules tied to trunk diameter and tree type. The company advises homeowners to confirm local requirements before scheduling work.
