Lucia Tirondola noted that adding carpentry to the company's services improves efficiency and accountability. Many exterior repairs use composite trim resistant to moisture, reducing maintenance and extending the life of the painted finish.

The same standards apply to interior work, where precise measurement and alignment are essential. Carpenters ensure proportion and symmetry by referencing architectural drawings or matching existing designs in historic homes. The goal is to maintain each property's character while enhancing functionality and appearance.

The continued development of the carpentry division reflects a growing trend among Northern Virginia homeowners to invest in long-term improvements rather than temporary updates. Combining carpentry with painting services allows residents to complete multiple upgrades within one project. The integrated approach

reduces the need for multiple contractors and ensures consistency from start to finish.
