Asbestos exposure poses significant health risks, including lung cancer, mesothelioma, and asbestosis. These diseases often develop decades after initial exposure, making prevention through proper identification and removal critically important. The microscopic fibers, when disturbed, become airborne and can be inhaled, lodging in lung tissue where they cause long-term damage.

Common areas where asbestos may be found in older homes include popcorn ceilings, vinyl floor tiles, pipe insulation, exterior siding, and attic insulation. The material remains safe when undisturbed and in good condition, but deterioration or renovation activities can release dangerous fibers into the air.

The Environmental Protection Agency recommends that homeowners have suspected materials tested by certified professionals before beginning any renovation or demolition work. Visual inspection alone cannot determine whether materials contain asbestos, as the fibers are too small to see with the naked eye.

"The cost of proper asbestos removal is minimal compared to the potential health consequences of exposure," McDonnell explained. "We encourage Nashville homeowners to be proactive about testing, especially if they're planning renovations or have noticed deteriorating materials in their homes."

Recent data from the Tennessee Department of Health indicates that mesothelioma rates in the state remain a concern, with many cases linked to residential asbestos exposure. This underscores the importance of professional assessment and remediation when asbestos is suspected.
